

Sentry Stainless Steel Shield H2O

Description	Sentry Stainless Steel Shield H2O is a concentrated water based one step cleaner, restorer and conditioner, designed to impart a self-healing durable film that repels and masks fingerprints and smudges.
Surface	Stainless Steel, Aluminum and Porcelain Appliances.
Solution	Repels and masks fingerprints and smudges.

Coverage	600 to 800 SqFt. /gal Coverage will vary depending on the porosity of substrate.
Surface Preparation	Surface must be clean, dry and in sound condition. To remove all oil, dust, grease, dirt, loose material including the removal of all existing silicon sealers. Use Sentry Step#1 Cleaner for Unpainted Surfaces then rinse with clean fresh water and dry completely.
Application Instruction	Test Area Due to a wide range of materials and blends of materials always test sample for compatibility. Application Shake container thoroughly before & during application. Wipe on using pre-moistened cloth and buff off.
Dry Time	Drying time is temperature and humidity dependent. Touch: 3-5 minutes. Through: 5-10 minutes.
Storage & Shelf Life	Do not freeze or boil. Use within 2 years of date of purchase.
Clean Up	Clean with warm, soapy water.
Maintenance	Reapply Sentry Stainless Steel H2O as needed to maintain desired appearance.
Caution	Short term harmful effects are not expected from vapor generated at ambient temperatures. Use ventilation as required to control vapor concentrations. Avoid skin contact. Wear normal work clothing. Individuals with sensitive skin conditions should wear gloves, outer clothing or apron, overshoes and a face-shield suitable to potential exposure. In the event of contact with skin, wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. In case of contact with eyes, immediately flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation persists. If accidentally swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Give two glasses of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.
